Funding for the scholarship program is provided by the IIANC Education Foundation.

### What's Included

- **P&C Licensing Course**-Set in a 40 hour classroom setting, this course prepares students to take the North Carolina State Exam for Property & Casualty licenses. Textbook and exam simulator is included. (Value: \$550)
- **State Licensing Exam and Application Fees**-The fee to take the Property & Casualty state licensing exam and applications fees will be reimbursed upon receipt of proof of passing the exam.
- **Career Center** - Access to IIANC's online career center, the [Career Clipboard](#), to search for available jobs with IIANC member agencies and post your resume for free.
